INTERNATIONAL SOCIETY FOR KRISHNA CONSCIOUSNESS OF CALIFORNIA INC.

WE, THE UNDERSIGNED, in order to form a non-profit, non-stock corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, under and pursuant to the provisions of the General Mon-profit Corporation Law of the State of California, do herebye certify as follows:

FIRST: The name of the proposed corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation") is:
INTERNATIONAL SOCIETY FOR KRISHMA CONSCIOUSNESS OF CALIFORNIA INC.

SECOND: The principal office for the transaction of the business of the Corporation is to be located in the County of Los Angeles, in the State of California.

THIRD: It is declared that His Divine Grace A.C.

Bhaktivedanta Swami Prabhupada is the Founder-Acarya of

the International Society for Krishna Consciousness of

California. He shall be the supreme authority with respect

to all matters of the Society, and that status shall not be

occupied by or shared with any other individual, either during his

lifetime, or after his death. His name and title must appear on all documents, letterheads, publications and buildings of the Society or Corporation.

be operated exclusively for the religious, charitable, literary and educational purposes, within the meaning of Section 501 (C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, and the regulations promulgated thereunder, and particularly for the following purposes:

- (a) To systematically propagate spiritual knowledge to society at large and to educate all peoples in the techniques of spiritual life in order to check the imbalance of values in life and to achieve real unity and peace in the world.
 - (b) To propagate a consciousness of Krishna as it is revealed in the <u>Bhagavad-gita As It Is</u>, <u>Srimad-</u> <u>Bhagavatam</u>, and other authorized Vedic literatures as translated and presented by His Divine Grace A.C. Bhaktivedanta Swami Prabhupada.

- (c) To bring the members of the Soceity together with each other and nearer to Krishna, the prime entity, and thus to develop the idea, within the members, and humanity at large, that each soul is part and parcel of the quality of Godhead (Krishna).
- (d) To teach and encourage the Sankirtan Movement, congressational chanting of the holy name of God, as revealed in the teachings of Lord Sri Caitanya Mahaprabhu.
- (e) To erect for the members, and for society at large, a holy place of transcendental pastimes, dedicated to the personality of Krishna.
- (f) To bring the members closer together for the purpose of teaching a simpler and more natural way of life.
- (g) With a view towards achieving the aferementioned purposes, to publish and distribute periodicals, magazines, books and other writings.
- (h) To receive, administer and distribute funds, and to do all other things necessary and proper in

furtherance of the above stated purposes.

(i) To recognize the Founder-Acarya of the
International Society for Krishna Consciousness,
His Divine Grace A.C. Bhaktivedanta Swami
Prabhupada, as the supreme authority in all
matters of the Corporation, or Society; His
personal representatives, the Governing
Body Commission, as his authorized agents
or executors, appointed by him according
to the document <u>Directions of Management</u>,
dated July 28, 1970.

exercize any power, nor shall it engage directly or indirectly in any activity, that would invalidate its status (a) as a corporation which is exempt from federal income taxation as an organization described in section 501 (C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or (b) as a corporation contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (C) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954.

SIXTH: The Corporation shall not be operated for the purpose of conducting a trade or business for profit, and no part of the net earnings or the assets of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to any member or other individual, nor shall any of such net carnings or assets of the Corporation be used other than for the purposes of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as the members of the Corporation, by majority vote thereof, shall determine, and none of such assets shall be distributed to, or divided among, any of the members of the Corporation.

The property of this Corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable or religious purposes, and in the unlikely even of liquidation, dissolution or abandonment of the owner, after providing for the debts and obligations thereof, the remaining assets will not inure to the benefit of any private person but will be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable or religious purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501

(C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

SEVENTH: The directors of the corporation whall have the power, either directly or indirectly, either alone or in conjunction with others, to do any and all lawful acts and things and to engage in any an all lawful activities which may be necessary, useful, suitable, desirable, or proper for the furtherance, accomplishment, fostering, or attainment of any or all of the purposes for which

the Corporation is organized. The Corporation shall exercise its powers in compliance with the exempt purposes of organizations set forth in Section 501 (C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its Regulations as the same now exist or as they may be hereafter amended from time to time.

EIGHTH: The Corporation's operations whall be conducted principally within the United States of America; subject to the laws of the State of California, the Corporation also may conduct operations in foreign countries.

NINTH: Except as otherwise provided by
law, or in this Certificate, or in any By-Law
of the Corporation, all of the affairs of the
Corporation shall be managed and all of the powers
of the Corporation shall be exercised by the
Board of Directors. However, the power to make,
alter, amend, change, add to or repeal the By-Laws
of the Corporation shall be reserved to the members
of the Corporation. The number of directors and
the manner of their election shall be as provided
for in the By-Laws, and unless otherwise provided
for therein, the election of directors need not by
by ballot.

TENTH: The Corporation shall not have authority to issue any capital stock. The conditions of membership in the Corporation, the rights and obligations of its members and the classification of members, if any, shall be as provided in the By-Laws.
