In the past Temple Presidents have written to Srila Prabhupad recommending a barticular devotes's initiation. Now that Srila Prabhupad has mand these representatives, Temple Presidents may henceforewin sand recommendation for first ani second distillation to whichever of these eleven representatives are nearest their temple. After considering the recommendation, these representatives may accept the devotes as an initiated disciple of Srila Prabhupad by giving a spiritumi name, or in the case of second initiation, by chapting on the Cayatri thread, just as Srila Prabhupad has done.
