Prabhupāda says;

“One should take initiation from a bona fide spiritual master coming in the disciplic succession, who is authorised by his predecessor spiritual master. This is called dīkṣā-vidhāna.”  
(S.B. 4.8.54, purport)

If they claim to be Prabhupāda disciples they must have authorization from Prabhupāda to be dīkṣā guru. However Prabhupāda never gave any such indication in fact he tells us what he wants below:  
In 1975 Prabhupāda said;

“This is the function of the GBC, to see that one may not be taken away by maya. The GBC should all be the instructor gurus. I am the initiator guru, and you should be the instructor guru by teaching what I am teaching and doing what I am doing. This is not a title, but you must actually come to this platform. This I want.” (Letter to Madhudvisa, 4/8/75)

Given the lies and deception perpetrated by ambitious so-called disciples it would be more folly to simply accept what they claim without question.

Where is the evidence that Prabhupāda received no such order?  
Since Prabhupāda is obviously qualified it is foolish to doubt his statement and require these "very insignificant thing" - details.
