About the Author

Patrick Geoffrois was born in Paris. He is a cofounding member of Electric Press, which was formed in his native city in 1969 to facilitate the publication of the poetry, prose and recordings of an avant-garde group of writers and musicians. Having gained a measure of public acclaims and recognition through Electric Press, Patrick was invited to contribute several poems to Parvis à L'écho des Cils, a collaborative volume of poetry, published by Jean-Jacques Pauvert, that also included works by Allan Ginsberg and William Burroughs. His writings are also featured in a edition of Opus, a French literary review. In addition, he formed along with several members of Electric Press the rock band, Mahogany Brain, which recorded three albums on the French label, Futura.

Shortly thereafter, Patrick withdrew from the public eye and began many years of extensive travel. During that time he represented Iskcon Press (USA, Europe, Asia) at the 1977 International Book Fair in Moscow. He lived alternately between Europe and India, where he begun organizing short seminars and lectures including Cairo University.

In 1979 he arrived in New Yoork City and resumed his musical interests. He played and toured with James Chance and the Contortions. Patrick currently resides in Manhattan where he is working on a forthcoming book of non fiction stories.

His interests, which have always focused on the studies and practice of Greater Magick, are reflected in his writings and music.

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
